Welcome to Sorenson and Sorenson! Since you are new to our practice, we wanted to tell you a little bit about ourselves. We have three ophthalmologists, Dr. Lionel Sorenson and his sons Dr. Robert Sorenson and Dr. Andrew Sorenson. Dr. Renée Wyckoff and Dr. Jamie Stonick are our optometrists.

In addition to routine eye exams, our practice provides cataract surgery, laser vision correction, glaucoma management and corneal transplants. We also have a full-service optical shop. For more information, visit our website at [www.Sorensoneye.com](http://www.Sorensoneye.com).

As an ophthalmology practice, we are responsible for the complete health of your eyes. Your initial complete exam will include a refraction to determine any prescription for glasses. We will also dilate your eyes so that the doctor can check their overall health. The doctor may request additional tests, if necessary. To make your visit go as smoothly as possible, please complete the enclosed registration forms and bring them with you the day of your appointment. (Please do not mail forms to the office.) Be sure to sign and date where required.

We would also like you to know a little about what to expect on your visit:

- Allow at least 2 hours for your exam. (Part of this time is spent waiting for your eyes to dilate). Additional testing may require more time. Contact lens fittings also take extra time.
- Be sure to verify with your insurance company what part(s) of your exam will be covered. Many insurance plans do not cover routine, healthy eye exams. Other plans cover only part of the visit.
- Medicare patients (including Secure Horizons) must pay \$55.00 for the refraction portion of the exam. This is not covered by insurance and is payable the day of the exam.  
Please note: All complete exams include a refraction.
- A parent or guardian must accompany minor patients (under age 18). Alternatively, the patient may bring a note signed by the parent/guardian giving us permission to see him/her.
- Neighborhood parking is limited; however, there is a parking lot behind our building which charges a fee.
